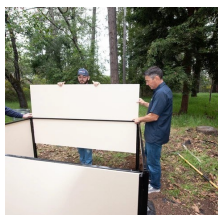

The Modular Fire Fence is constructed of steel tubing in non-combustible fiber cement boards and coated with intumescent fire resistant paint (Systems Overview and Elements FFA & FFE). This system is available in 48" wide by 42" tall modular sections that can be assembled quickly in a square, rectangle or, octagon formation. - **Update your social media profiles.** Tell people if you're okay, where you are and what you need.
